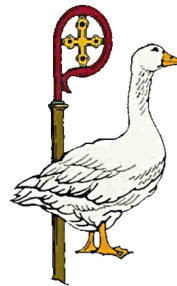

St. Martin's has had a relationship with the Diocese of Durgapur in West Bengal, India, since



2010. Through our visits, St. Martin's **India Ministry** has partnered with local people, developing relationships and serving the poorest of the poor – the “untouchables” and the tribal people. We have provided housing for children in a leper colony, established libraries, created a sewing center that trains licensed tailors, funded cataract surgeries, and arranged for the sponsorship of 41 children. In 2016, we funded a program of Anti Human Trafficking near the



border of West Bengal and Bangladesh. None of our work in India is proselytizing; most served are Hindu, Muslim or tribal.

Re-Member is a non-profit outreach organization that has co-existed with the Lakota people on the Pine Ridge Reservation in South Dakota since 1999. Re-Member reaches out to stitch the threads of relationship back together. More than 1200 volunteers come together annually from all over the world to serve the Lakota people. Volunteers learn the cultural traditions as they work to improve living conditions of the tribal members.



Pine Ridge Reservation is one of the most impoverished communities in N. America. Your contributions will help to provide bunkbeds, outhouses, porches, wheelchair ramps, and firewood.

Everyone needs a stable place to live! **Open Doors Kalamazoo** helps working families and individuals prevent and overcome homelessness. We offer temporary shelter, affordable housing, and personal relationship to over 250 local men, women, and children each year. We emphasize employment and personal responsibility.
